Shots For Tots Club Recognition Program

Shots For Tots Vision : The Vision of the Indiana District **Shots For Tots** Program is that all communities within the state of Indiana meet or exceed the 2010 Immunization Rate of 90 percent.

Shots For Tots Mission : The Mission of the Indiana District **Shots For Tots** Program is to promote childhood immunizations and increase community awareness about immunization related issues through collaboration and education.

Shots For Tots Goal: The Goal of the Indiana District **Shots For Tots** Program is for all Kiwanis Clubs to participate in community immunization related programs thus helping to improve the statewide immunization rate. Kiwanis Club participation can be achieved through a variety of means as listed below (but is not limited to those listed).

1. Participation in a Community **Shots For Tots** event such as a SUPER SHOT SATURDAY or recurring community Immunization event
2. Assisting County Health Departments with a “Reminder/Recall” notification program. Clubs can contact parents about their child’s immunization due dates.
3. Distribution of educational literature promoting timely immunization of children.
4. Underwriting the cost of immunization related educational materials and/or a community project.
5. Assisting with the promotion of the **Children’s and Hoosier’s Immunization Registry Program (C.H.I.R.P.)** and/or assisting with the C.H.I.R.P. data entry when immunizations are administered.
6. Assisting the local health department or other immunization related agency with production of Public Service Announcements (PSA’s) for local area dissemination.
7. Forming or joining a local immunization coalition which focuses on improving childhood immunization rates.
8. Other Immunization related actions which will help the state of Indiana improve its immunization rate to the 2010 immunization goal of 90 percent or better.

Shots For Tots Participation Patch : Kiwanis clubs that participate in the Indiana District **Shots For Tots** program as noted above (or in some other meaningful manner not noted above) are eligible to receive a **Shots For Tots** Patch at the Mid Year Conference based on the previous administrative year. Clubs eligible for Recognition consideration should complete the attached form and submit details of your club's participation in an immunization related event. Submissions should be sent to the District Chair for evaluation no later than October 31st of each year. Patches will be presented to Club Presidents (or a club representative) at the Mid Year Conference.

SHOTS FOR TOTS SUPER STAR Club: Clubs whose immunization related service excels above and beyond the norm will be considered for the **Shots For Tots** Super Star Patch (to be determined by the District Chair and Indiana Immunization Coalition Representative).
