### Supporter—\$100/member

Clubs that contribute \$100/member (either in a single year or cumulatively over four years) will be recognized at the Supporter level.

### Donor—\$200/member

Clubs that contribute \$200/member (either in a single year or cumulatively over four years) will be recognized at the Donor level.

### Partner—\$300/member

Clubs that contribute \$300/member (either in a single year or cumulatively over four years) will be recognized at the Partner level.

*Indiana District of Kiwanis and Riley Hospital for Children's longstanding relationship dates back more than 90 years. Kiwanis started raising funds in 1919 to help Riley open its doors to serve the children of Indiana.*



*Indiana pediatricians list health support for children with neurodevelopmental and behavioral disorders (NDBD) as their number one need. One-in-six children has a neurodevelopmental or behavioral problem. One-of-68 children has Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD). In Indiana, the average age of diagnosis is 63 months, nearly twice the national average. Earlier diagnosis for effective care—under the age of 36 months—is paramount to maximize treatment.*



Indiana District of Kiwanis pledged \$1,000,000 to ensure young children throughout the state of Indiana receive effective and timely care for NDBD. This pledge will allow Riley Hospital for Children to provide resources on a community-level across Indiana by opening early diagnosis hubs to provide support, education, and training to local pediatric and family medical practices.

## The Fine Print

- Official start of the year membership numbers published by Kiwanis International will be used to determine per member contributions.
- Contributions are cumulative during the four-year 3 Wishes campaign, beginning October 1, 2015 and ending September 30, 2019. Clubs will be recognized as contributions increase from one level to the next.
- Clubs will be recognized each year and receive a banner patch appropriate to the level achieved for that year.
- Individual gifts made through the Riley Honors program will be credited to the member's home club contribution total as pledges are fulfilled.
