## Items Needed for the Food Pantry

### Non-Food Items:

- Reusable shopping bags (new): Used by families to carry their food to their vehicle
- Feminine Hygiene Products (tampons, pads, panty liners): Many patient families experiencing food insecurity also lack adequate access to the products
- Household Items (toilet paper, paper towels, disinfecting wipes, dish soap, etc.): Families discharging after extended hospitalizations typically benefit from these items
